

BUILDING PERMITS: One building permit for an addition to an existing garage was reviewed and approved.

STATUS OF UTILITY ACCOUNTS: Currently carrying \$12,457 in outstanding utility bills.

BUDGET: Currently the Sewer Fund is in the hole, partly from outstanding payments. The system is getting old and slowly needing more and more repairs, therefore costing us more. We are currently working on our Sewer System Plan to be eligible for future funding. Council made the recommendation to increase the sewer portion of the bill \$2.

The recycling fees are more than anticipated but we are collecting enough to cover the cost. People from outside the city limits need to pay the same as the town people (\$1 a month) if they are going to use it.

SNOW PLOW GUIDELINES: Parking on the street is prohibited. Alleys must be kept at a 20' width. Please check your alleyway to make sure it is free and clear by removing all clutter, including all overgrown bushes, shrubs and trees. If a car is parked on the street the snow plow will not clear that side of the road. There will not be a second trip if the plow comes by before vehicles are moved. The same applies to parking in the alleys.

*Snowmobiles are permitted only on arterials, only at a slow speed, only to get in and out of Town.

*Leaving faucets turned on slowly during low temperatures can help avoid frozen
